

The American Board of Veterinary Ophthalmology (ABVO) Statement on Ethics and Professionalism

The American Board of Veterinary Ophthalmology (ABVO) requires that all individuals seeking to acquire or maintain board certification must maintain the highest level of ethical and professional behavior with respect to the credentialing process. The ABVO maintains a zero tolerance policy for persons engaged in unethical behavior defined as cheating; lying; falsifying information; misrepresenting one's educational background or professional experience; using inappropriate terms to represent themselves either during or after their training program; disclosure, publication, reproduction or transmission of ABVO examinations, in any form or by any means, for any purpose; sharing examination information or discussing an examination while in progress or at any time thereafter; giving or receiving assistance during any phase of the certification or maintenance of certification process; and recall and reconstruction of the exam questions by any means.
